This week we communicated to families about the RAT distributions for the remainder of the term. We are now moving into symptomatic testing. This means that all children at Lansvale PS will receive 8 tests per child to be used if children are displaying any covid-19 symptoms. These RATs have been sent home with the oldest child.



We also continue to implement our COVID-Smart measures at school which include vaccinations, physical distancing where possible, maximised fresh air flow through natural ventilation, continued good hand hygiene practices and enhanced cleaning.

Congratulations to Aida!






A few friendly reminders



WHAT IS BYOD?

All classes from Year 3 to Year 6 are BYOD classes. BYOD stands for Bring Your Own Device. Lansvale Public School acknowledges the educational value of digital devices and online services in supporting and enhancing educational outcomes and student wellbeing. Digital technology can empower authentic, meaningful, collaborative and engaged learning and can better prepare students for their lives beyond the school.

REGISTRATION FOR BYOD

Students are able to bring their own devices to school once they have completed an online registration with parents or guardians and both have signed the User Agreement. Translators can be made available for those who need assistance with the process. If you need the registration note again, please let your classroom teacher know.

BYOD LOAN DEVICES

In order to extend student learning, students have been given the opportunity to loan a device from Lansvale Public School for use at school and home.

This year we will be implementing a non-refundable Loan Device fee of \$100 for all students requesting a loan device. We have had to introduce this fee in order to aid in the sustainability of our ever growing fleet of loan devices. To ensure the safety of device charging at home, this \$100 will include a new charger and cable for every child each year, as well as a maintenance fee to help us cover the cost of updating ageing devices. Students will be able to take the device home unless other arrangements have been made with the classroom teacher.

BYOD USAGE

Students will not be allowed to use digital devices before or after school on school grounds, during class time, recess and lunch, unless for an educational purpose or where a student needs it for other reasons, such as an adjustment to support their learning and wellbeing. During Primary Schools Sports Association (PSSA), devices are required to be left at school until they return from sport. Devices are not permitted during camps or excursions. In addition, we kindly ask that parents monitor their children's usage at home.


